The Gallery at Plymouth Public Library is hosting an Art Show in conjunction with the Plymouth Public Library's Summer 2022 Reading Program. Both the Summer Reading Program and Art Show are entitled **"Off the Beaten Path"**.

We hope that artwork will represent some of the many hidden treasures that can be found in our charming seaside town. The show will hang from July 5 thru October 1 2022 to coincide with the Library's Summer Reading Program.

Submissions of artwork can be delivered to the Plymouth Public Library on June 28th or 29th, from 10 am – 5 pm. Selections will be made and juried in anticipation of the official opening on Tuesday, July 5th.

There are no fees for entry. We simply ask that artists gift 10% of the sale of their work of art to the Plymouth Public Library Foundation.

The Plymouth Public Library Foundation will host an **OPENING RECEPTION** on Friday, August 5th, from 6 to 8 pm for all artists and their guests. On Saturday, the PPLF will host our annual Arts & Crafts Festival from 10 am to 5 pm on the Library's front lawn. The Festival draws over 3000 people annually AND the art show will be available for all attendees to view.
