

CALL FOR MASTER BUILDER LEGO BRICK ARTISTS - March 9, 2024


The Plymouth Public Library Foundation is pleased to announce its 5th Annual Juried Fine Arts and Crafts Festival. The Festival will take place on the Plymouth Public Library Lawn, 132 South Street, Plymouth, MA from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM on Saturday, August 10 and Sunday August 11, 2024.

This year's Festival will feature an exhibit comprised of custom builds made out of LEGO bricks. Each build must have as its theme a location, event, structure or other aspect of the town of Plymouth's history, attractions, seaside, buildings, monuments Native American Heritage, etc. Builds are to be completed before August 10 and will be displayed during the two day Festival. Awards for judged creations in various categories will be given, with top entries being displayed in the Library for a bit.

The Festival also features original and handcrafted canvas art, sculpture, woodwork, glass creations, fabric art, pottery, fashion, jewelry, metalwork. In addition, there is family entertainment, food and special exhibits. Festival proceeds will be used to support the many cultural, artistic and educational programs offered by the Plymouth Public Library.
